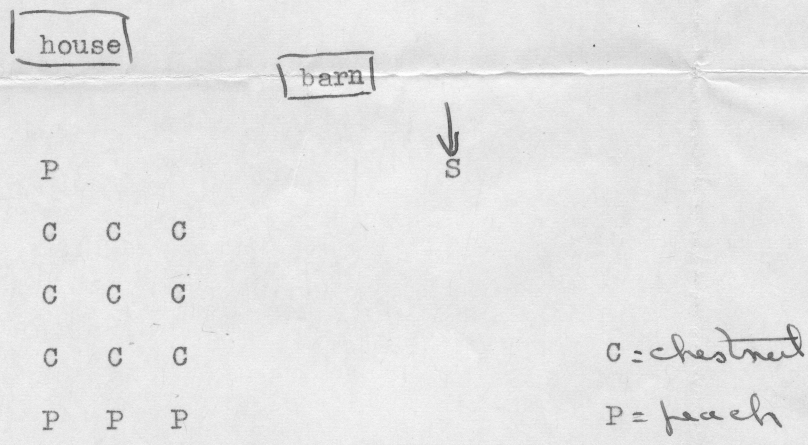


Deatsville, Alabama; J. R. Farmby, Holtsville High School

Sent the following in 1939; 20 S-8 Jap. chinq. hybred

Mr. Farmby lives in the third house on right, east of the high school.

At the time of my visit Mr. Farmby was not in town. Some of the trees have been planted in his back yard. These are doing well. They have made between 5 and 8 inches growth this summer. No twig blight or chestnut blight, ground level, sandy loam. Trees are planted as part of an orchard, mostly peach. See diagram below



Since Mr. Farmby instructs in agriculture in the H.S. it is probable that the remainder of the trees were used in some school project.
