Good sandy soil in orchard, level land, low. heavy weed growth, trees have been neglected during change of ownership. Mr. Rogers plans to give them more care now that he has things organized. He formerly worked for Mr. Smith and is quite interested in the chestnuts. He would like some more if any are available.

The 1938 lot of trees is making good growth, mostly around 8 to 10 inches this year. The stock in this lot far surpasses the 1936 lot. This lot arrived late in the season and apparently never has really got started.
