Tree # 2. Twenty ft. high, 8 in. stem. The "Bartlett" Chestnut?!

Tree # 3. Five ft., 1 in. stem.

Tree # 4. Twig fungus and pruning cut down size. Has C.B.
Has produced large nuts but not prolific.

Tree # 5. Sprout from original tree which was cut off at stem. Sprout
10 ft. high, 2 in. stem.

Tree # 6. 18 ft. high, 6 in. stem.

Tree # 7. 18 ft. high, stump diam. 8 in.

Tree # 8. 25 ft. high, 10 in. stump diam.
