One tree - 20 to 25 feet high. Top had been trimmed to allow for telephone wires. Tree looked fairly vigorous. Has fruited in previous years but none were noticeable now. Nuts had been sound. Only a few formed. A sterium rot had set in at a large branch stub towards the base of tree. R.M.L. - 1928.
