In regard to chestnut seedlings "I do not believe these trees have suffered at all from winter injury, but they are suffering very badly from cottontail rabbit. As a matter of fact, the rabbits attack the chestnut more than any other tree or shrub around here, so more than likely the cottontail will stop any effort to establish the tree",
