11/2/39 sent 32 lbs net Paragons (9 ♀♀ bought 8 lbs additional for his farm). FP. 965. He also sent 18 lbs net C. dentata nuts FP. 970.

1951 - One Amer. chestnut tree still living; planted about 1900; in front yard on Highway 15, 2 mi so. of Bristol, Ind. Weevils no problem in Northern Indiana

Reported 6/15/26 by Mr. Reed. Trees planted during the 90's.

June 21, 1927 I counted 110 trees ranging in height from 8-25 ft. and in DBH 2-10 in. 10 of the 110 growing in fence row.

62 trees 20 or more years old.

38 trees 5-10 yrs. old.

6 trees showed blight with one or more flags.

1 tree about half blighted; 1 tree killed by blight; sprouts healthy. Besides the grown trees Mr. Gorton has some 200 seedling grown from seeds last year, 8-12 in. high. Mr. Gorton is in the 90's
