The curriculum is designed to cover the following: basic military drill and ceremony, church and casket protocol, developing department SOPs for honor and color guards, public safety officer benefits, flag etiquette, proper military courtesies, 21 gun salutes, basic instruction for bagpipe, honor guard commander leadership training, various types of funeral services, and honor and color guard history. This course also utilizes the Incident Command System when preparing for a funeral event.
