The April 19, 2013 memorandum issued by the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) in this docket states that the Council’s procedure will include a “public site review.” Given the visual effects and visual mitigation issues involved in this docket, the City of Meriden (“City”) respectfully requests that the public site review include the following locations from which Meriden Gas Turbines, LLC’s electric generating facility can be seen:

1. Broadview Terrace (off Broad Street near the I-691 entrance)
2. The Preston Avenue overpass over I-691
3. Hunter Golf Club Hole No. 4
4. Quiet Brook Court

The City will make appropriate arrangements for parking, public safety, and, in the case of Hunter Golf Club, transportation.
