First-Year Operating Report

May 21, 2018 - May 20, 2019

In accordance with Section 5(b) of the Connecticut Siting Council's ("Council") Decision and Order in Docket No. 192B, dated May 14, 2015, CPV Towantic, LLC ("CPV Towantic") submits this First-Year Operating Report to the Council within three months after the conclusion of the first year of operation for its facility located in Oxford, CT. The First-Year Operating Report is required to include:

- 1. The number of hours when operation on natural gas was curtailed and ULSD was burned, facility capacity and availability, and the number of and reasons for any interruption in electric generation; and
- 2. Overall condition and reliability of the facility.

Initially, CPV Towantic would like to clarify the commercial operation date of the facility. On May 16, 2018, CPV Towantic submitted a letter to the Council in accordance with Condition 4(c) of the Decision and Order stating that it would commence commercial operation on June 1, 2018. At the time of submittal of the letter, that was CPV Towantic's expectation of the commercial operation date. In a subsequent Quarterly Progress Report, Q2-2018, dated July 10, 2018, CPV Towantic notified the Council that the facility actually achieved commercial operation on May 21, 2018. Accordingly, the timeframe for this First-Year Operating Report is May 21, 2018 through May 20, 2019.

As to the first-year of operation, there were no periods when ULSD was burned due to natural gas curtailments. The only periods of ULSD operation were during commissioning and testing of the ULSD systems. During its first-year of operation, the facility was in steady state condition, operating normally within its design specifications. See table below for more information.
