Pursuant to Condition No. 5.a of the Connecticut Siting Council's Decision and Order, dated May 14, 2015, CPV Towantic, LLC ("the Project") hereby submits its Quarterly Progress Report for the 4th Quarter of 2015.

The status of the Project's permits during Q4-2015 is as follows:

- On November 30, 2015, the Connecticut Department of Energy & Environmental Protection ("CT DEEP") issued final the Project's New Source Review Permit to Construct and Operate a Stationary Source, Nos. 144-0023 through 114-0027.
- On December 7, 2015, CT DEEP issued its Notice of Permit Authorization for the Project's registration for the General Permit for the Discharge of Stormwater and Dewatering Wastewaters from Construction Activities under Permit No. GSN002950 to authorize the stormwater discharge.
- On December 16, 2015, the Project filed its Title IV Acid Rain permit application with CT DEEP and the United States Environmental Protection Agency.

On December 21, 2015, Audubon Connecticut confirmed in writing the sale of 0.24 credits through its In-Lieu Fee program to compensate for 10,500 square feet of impacts to wetlands as authorized in U.S. Army Corps Permit No. NAE-2014-2062.

- On December 22, 2015, Oral Arguments by Plaintiffs and Defendants heard by Judge Schuman in New Britain Superior Court.
- On January 12, 2016, Judge Schuman issued the final decision dismissing the appeal.
