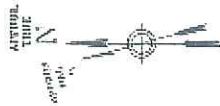

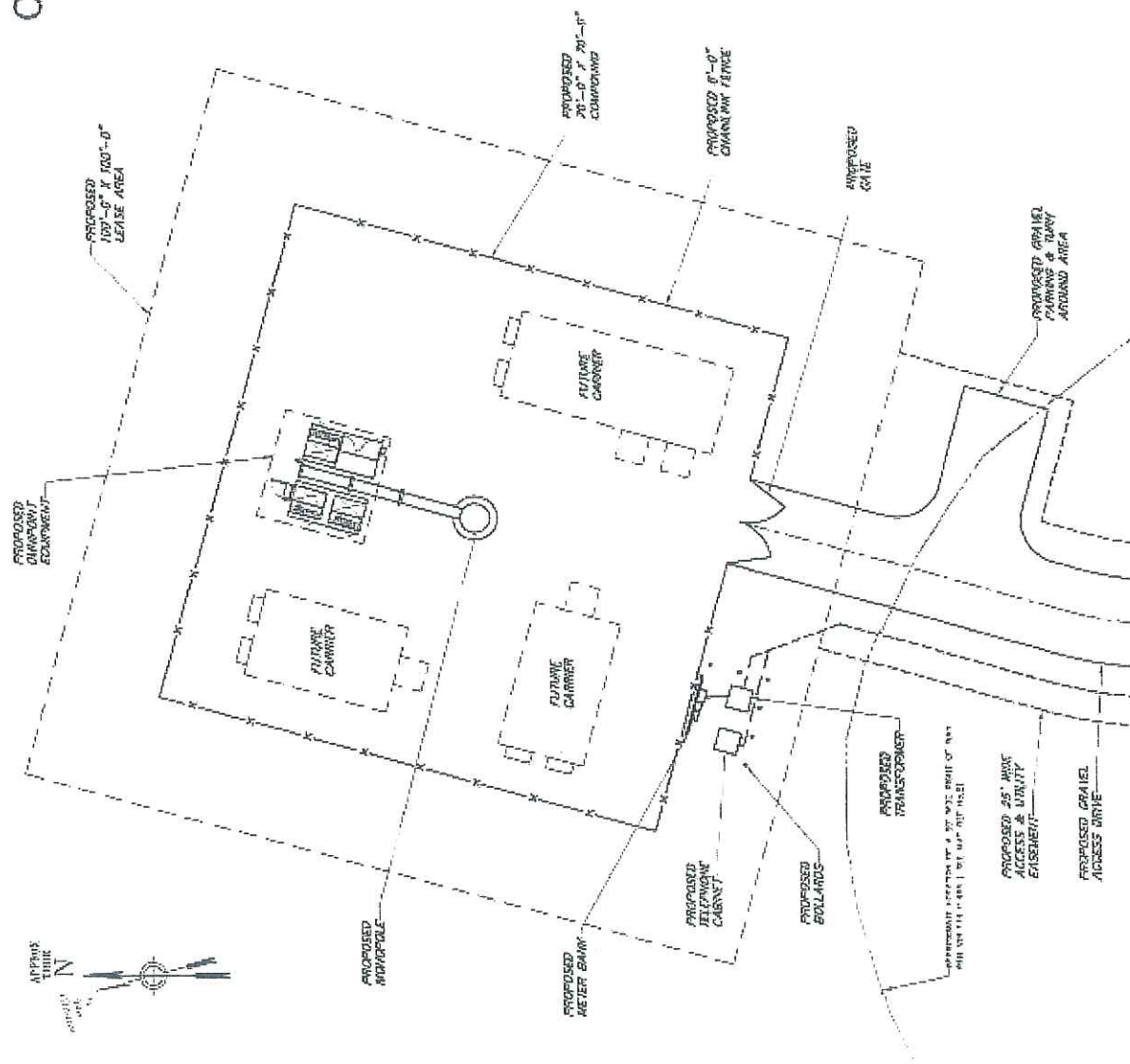
ABUTTERS MAP

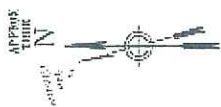

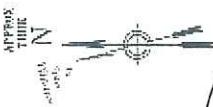
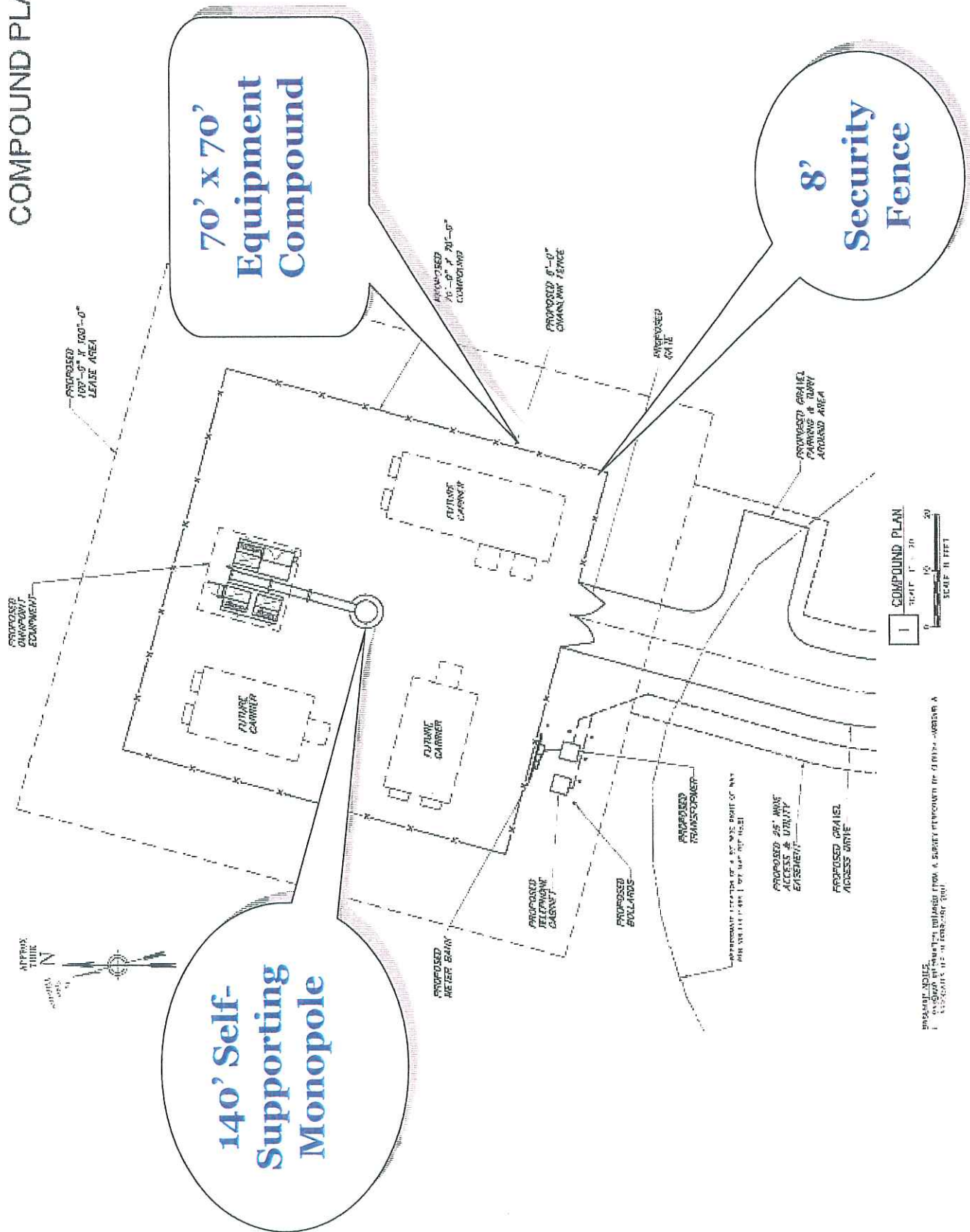

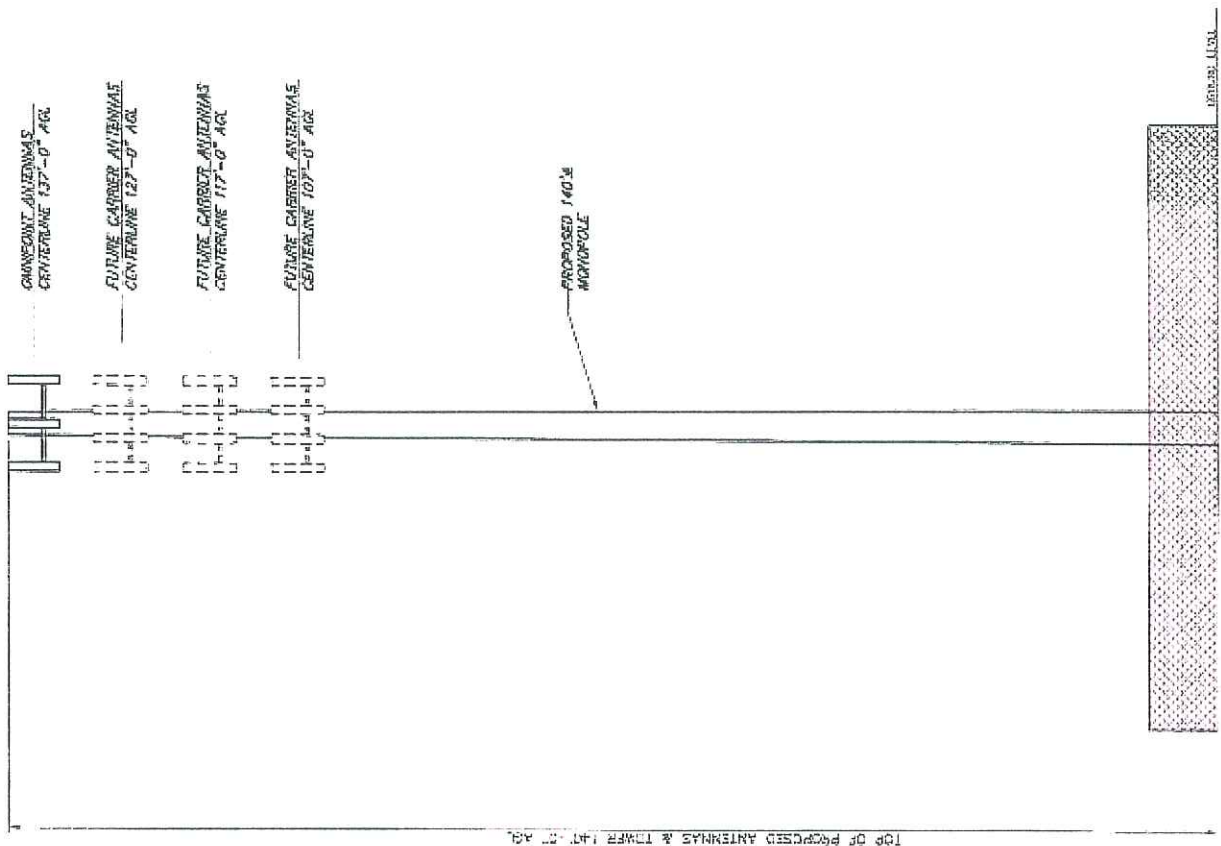

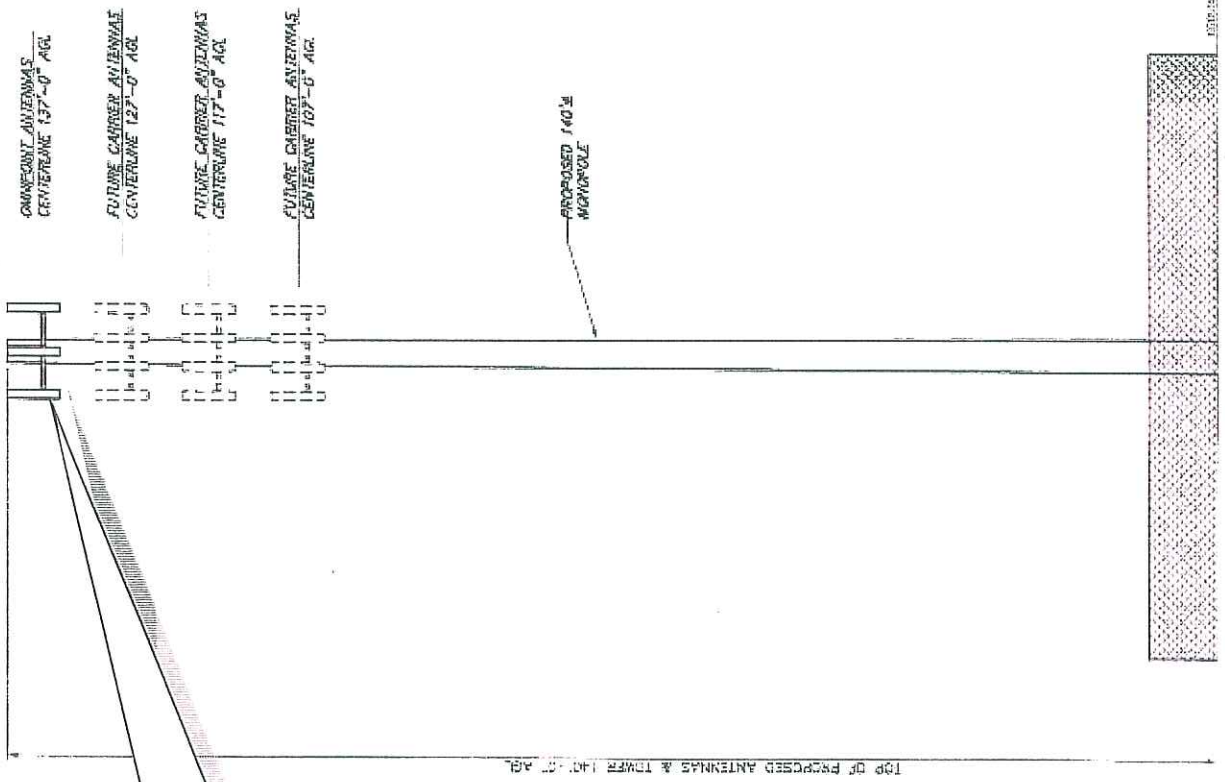

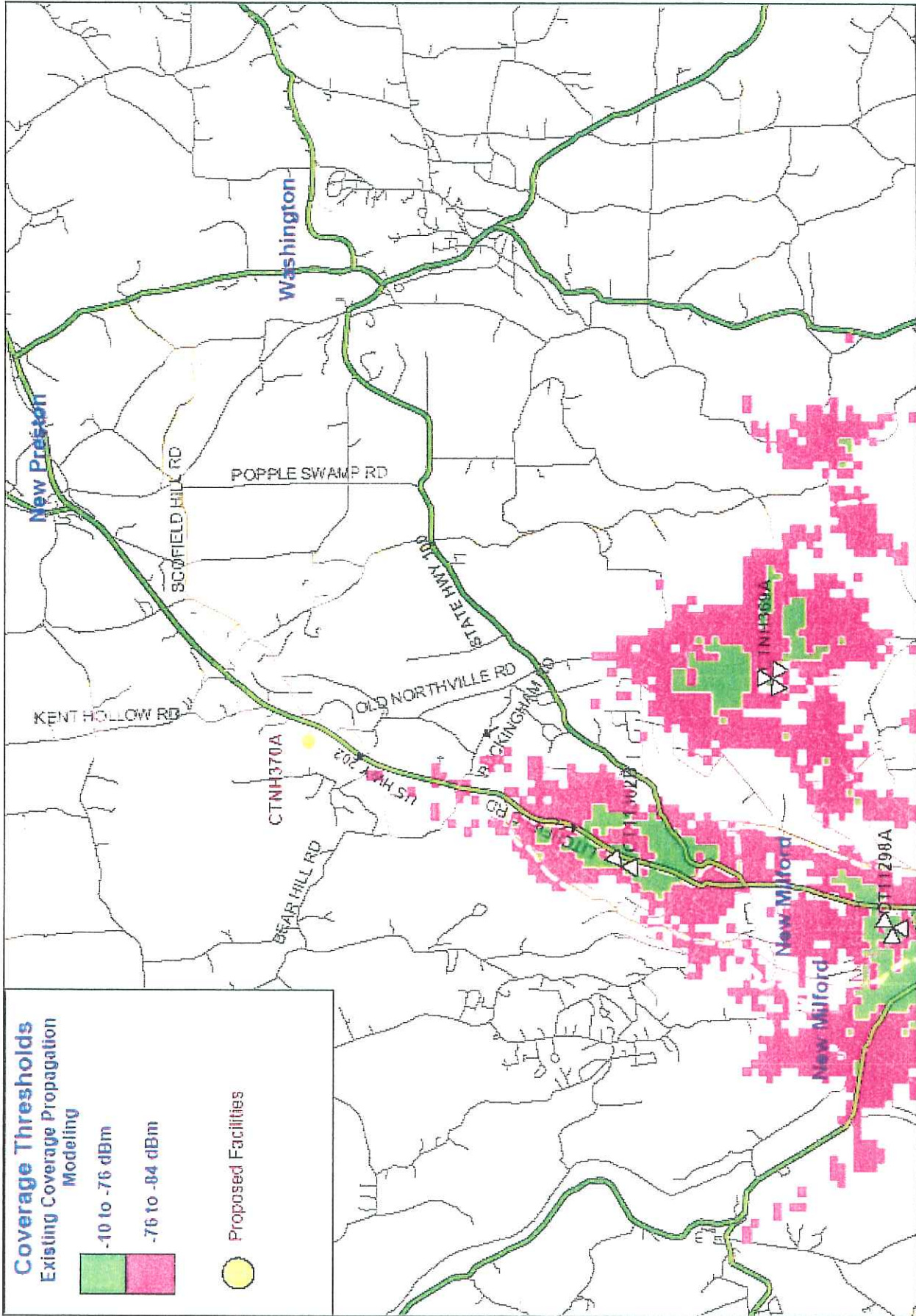

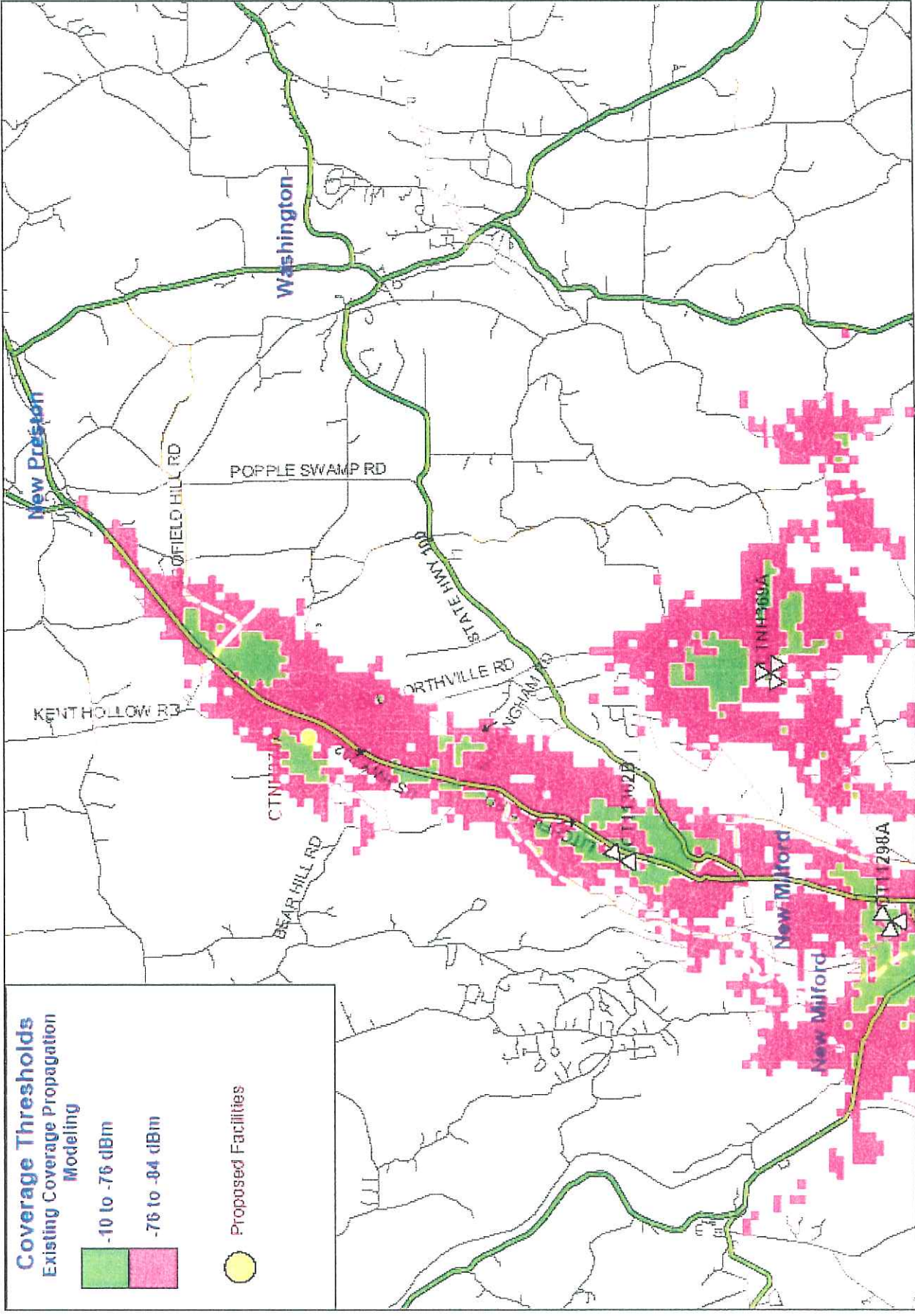
Coverage Thresholds

Existing T-Mobile On Air Coverage

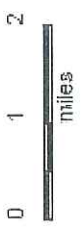

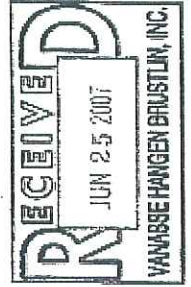
