1. Manner in which petitioner claims to be substantially and specifically affected:

The Lower Connecticut River Gateway Commission is a public agency empowered by State Statute to protect the “*natural and traditional riverway scene*” within the lower Connecticut River valley (Sections 25-102a through 25-102s CGS). The Agency has been in existence since 1973.


Review of the Application materials indicates that the proposed location off Cove Road is within the Gateway Conservation Zone boundary as defined in Statute and, as such, the proposed location and height of the tower (180 feet) may impact the visual quality of properties within the Conservation Zone. As a result, the replacement of the tower is considered potentially adverse to and inconsistent with the legislative goals and policies of the Gateway Commission. It is understood that the proposed tower is to replace a previously existing “similar” tower owned by CL&P that was located on the site in question.

2. Manner and extent to which petitioner proposes to participate:

The Gateway Commission proposes participation primarily for the purposes of cross-examining the Applicant and to comment on the application to insure that the proposed tower location and height is that alternative which will result in the least visual and environmental impact to the Connecticut River and properties within the Gateway Conservation Zone.
