Dear Mr. Caruso,

I am writing to you to formally request intervenor status in petition/docket No. 350. This petition has been filed by Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless and they are seeking to erect a cellular tower on land that abutts my home. The site choice requested in petition# 350 is located at Old Turnpike Road and Route 198 in Woodstock, CT.

I have attached 2 documents to this email for your review. The first is page one of the intervenor form that is listed on the Ct Siting Council website. I used the autofill feature on your website and used 2 pages to fully document my information. Unfortunately, only page one of my two pages would print. Since this was also the signature page, I have scanned in (and attached to this email) a separate page of the official intervenor form. This second attachment contains only my signature and date.

Since my second page would not print out, I would like to provide what I had completed on your online form here below instead. Before I do, let me also please state that I have sent a copy of this email with both attachments to the attorney for Cellco/Verizon, Mr. Kenneth C. Baldwin of Robinson & Cole. I am copying him this email because the Siting Council intervenor form states that copies of an intervenor request must be provided to all participants at least 5 business days before the hearing.

If you are not able to read either (or both) of my email attachments for any reason, please do not hesitate to contact me and I will re-scan and resend them to you.

The second page of my intervenor form follows below:

2. Manner and extent to which petitioner proposes to participate:

I recently met with a neighbor of mine. He has land here in Woodstock that is located in close proximity to the currently proposed site on Old Turnpike Road/Route 198. My neighbor would like Verizon to seriously consider his land as an alternative site choice. He tells me that his land has a higher elevation than the currently proposed site. In addition, there is existing vehicular access to the parcel and utilities are already present at the site. I am told that his (approximately) 56 acres of land is near to fewer homes so the residential impact should be less. It should also be noted that my neighbor's land does not abutt a nearly undeveloped and pristine body of water such as Black Pond.

My neighbor would like to accompany both myself and/or a fellow neighbor of ours (Aleksandr Motovilov; another abutting property owner) to the upcoming Siting Council hearing. My understanding is that this hearing is presently scheduled for February 7, 2008 at the Woodstock Town Hall. In the event that there is not enough time between now and February 7, 2008 to investigate his land, my neighbor wishes to come to the hearing with me to personally offer his land as an alternative to the Siting Council as it deliberates this matter.

Therefore, I propose to participate in the hearing by exercising my right as an abutting landowner and bringing a

neighbor/landowner to also participate in the hearing process. We wish to offer the Siting Council and Verizon Wireless one more alternative site choice before the Siting Council renders its final decision regarding petition/docket #350. I respectfully request that the Siting Council ask Verizon to give serious and fair consideration to my neighbor's land as it seems to present a potentially better choice than the site that is currently being considered. 1. Manner in which petitioner claims to be substantially and specifically affected:

I am an abutting property owner. My home will be located approximately 1000 feet (diagonally) from the cell tower once it is erected at the site located at Old Turnpike Rd. and Rt. 198 as currently proposed by Cellco (d/b/a/ Verizon Wireless). There should already be an email on file (written by me) that was directed to the attention of Mr. Caruso. The email details my personal concerns about living within such close proximity to a cellular tower. I am aware that my concerns are not allowed to be considered under the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. Nevertheless, I remain extremely concerned. While I fully intend to comply with the law and will not discuss these concerns at the hearing, they are the underlying basis for my wishing to intervene in the matter of this petition.
