PRE-HEARING QUESTIONS, SET ONE TO OPTASITE TOWERS, LLC AND OMNIPOINT COMMUNICATIONS, INC.

The Applicant, Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless ("Cellco") requests responses to the following pre-hearing questions from Intervenors, Optasite Towers LLC ("Optasite") and Omnipoint Communications, Inc. ("OCI"), on or before March 4, 2008.

Question No. 1

Provide a multi-signal level coverage plot, at a scale of 1:63,360 that depicts OCI coverage from existing OCI sites in New Milford, the proposed Docket No. 355 Cellco site at a height of 140 feet, and the recently approved Docket No. 332 Cellco site at 6 Mountain Road, Washington, Connecticut, at a height of 140 feet. (Site Coordinates: 41° 40′ 8.93″ N, 73° 21′ 55.02″ W; Ground Elevation: 693 feet AMSL).

Question No. 2

Does Optasite or OCI have a lease or option to lease any property for a future cell site to the east of Cellco's approved Washington North cell site at 6 Mountain Road? If yes, is this site intended to provide coverage along Route 202?

Question No. 3

Does OCI currently share the existing tower located at 1291-1293 Bantam Road in Litchfield, Connecticut? If so, at what height are OCI antennas located?

Question No. 4

Following up on OCI's response to Siting Council Interrogatory No. 2, does OCI have any search areas or network design plans (funded or unfunded) for cell sites within a five mile radius of Cellco's proposed Northville Fire Department site?
