

LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-50l (b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Regulations pertaining thereto, of an application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (the "Application") to be submitted to the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on or about February 8, 2008 by Wireless *EDGE* Fairfield Group LLC ("Wireless *EDGE* or Applicant"). The Application proposes to construct a 150 foot tall steel monopole and an approximately 8,464 square foot compound area on a 71.14 acre parcel of property located at Margerie Reservoir Water Filtration Plant, Peck Road, Danbury. This property is owned by the City of Danbury and currently is undeveloped ("Site"). The City of Danbury has approved the erection of the telecommunication facility at this Site and has entered into a lease agreement with Wireless *EDGE* to allow them to do so.

The facility is proposed as a monopole telecommunications facility with co-located antennas no higher than 170 feet, and appurtenant base station equipment located within a 92' by 92' fenced compound ("Facility"). The Facility will be designed to accommodate the antenna arrays and ground equipment of City of Danbury public safety communications systems, if necessary, and Sprint/Nextel, as well as the co-location of at least five other licensed carriers or colocators. The location and other features of the proposed Facility are subject to change under provisions of Connecticut General Statutes §§ 16-50g to 16-50z, inclusive.

The Facility is proposed to eliminate and reduce existing coverage gaps experienced by licensed telecommunications carriers that propose to locate on the Facility. Such co-location on the Facility will provide coverage to a substantial portion of Danbury that is currently without adequate wireless telecommunications service, specifically along Route 37.

Weather permitting, the Applicant will raise a balloon at a representative height at the Site from 3 to 5 pm on the day of the Council's first hearing session on the Application, or at a

time otherwise specified by the Council. Interested parties and residents of the City of Danbury are invited to review the Application during normal business hours at any of the following offices:
