NOTICE OF INTENT TO BE A PARTY

Pursuant to §16-50n (a) of the Connecticut General Statutes, IMTIAZ N. WAHLA hereby gives notice and respectfully requests that the Connecticut Sitting Council (hereinafter “Council”) deem her to be a party to these proceedings for the following reasons:

1. That she is the owner in fee simple absolute of 461 Wickham Road, Glastonbury, Connecticut, a property abutting one of the two alternative sites listed in the application submitted to the Council by Optasite Towers LLC and Omnipoint Communications, Inc. (hereinafter “Co-Applicants”) on or about March 17th, 2008 (hereinafter “Application”), and thus entitled to participate as a party;
2. Alternatively, that because she is a party entitled to receive a copy of the Application pursuant to §16-50l of the Connecticut General Statutes and that this notice of intent to be a party is timely submitted, she is thus entitled to participate as a party;

3.
