Dear Ms. Underhill:

I am in receipt of your April 18, 2008 letter regarding the proposed Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless ("Cellco") application currently pending before the Connecticut Siting Council for the construction of a telecommunications tower in Falls Village, Connecticut. Don Owen from your office has been very helpful and cooperative in his review and consideration of our proposal. I have reviewed the requested mitigation measures which were recommended by representatives of the Appalachian Mountain Club, the Appalachian Trail Conservancy, and the National Park Service. This letter will serve as notice to you and your staff that Cellco is committed to complying with these conditions and will ask the Connecticut Siting Council to include them as conditions of approval in its final decision and order.

To confirm if the Siting Council application is approved, (1) Cellco agrees to purchase, deliver and plant approximately 25 white pine trees of a minimum height of five feet at a location along the Appalachian Trail near Warren Turnpike as directed by the National Park Service designated representative, Adam Brown of the Appalachian Trail Conservancy. We will contact Mr. Brown immediately following the Council's final decision on this application; and (2) consistent with its lease agreement with the Falls Village Fire Department, Cellco is committed to constructing a "monopine" tower at the subject property.

Once again, thank you for your cooperation and assistance with this matter.
