

The proposed Facility will be located in the south-western corner of the parcel and will consist of a 140-foot self-supporting monopole tower with flush-mounted panel antennas and a 55'x 90' fenced and screened equipment compound designed to accommodate unattended equipment either in single-story equipment buildings or on concrete pads. The location, height and other features of the proposed Facility are subject to review and potential change under provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes Sections 16-50g et seq.
