RE: **DOCKET NO. 366** – SBA Infrastructure, LLC Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility located at 52 Stadley Rough Road in Danbury, Connecticut.

On November 24, 2015, SBA Infrastructure LLC (SBA) filed a Request to Reopen and Modify the Connecticut Siting Council's (Council) April 23, 2009 issuance of a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (Certificate) to SBA Infrastructure LLC for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility at 52 Stadley Rough Road in Danbury, Connecticut.

Specifically, the request relates to the removal of a portion of Condition No. 1 of the Certificate and the Superior Court Stipulated Judgment that requires "all antennas attached to the monopole shall be flush-mounted." Due to increased consumer demand and usage, as well as optimization of E911 data transfer speed and capacity, SBA is requesting use of T-arm antenna mounts rather than flush antenna mounts on this existing tower to avoid increasing the height of the tower to comply with the flush antenna mount condition.

The Request to Reopen and Modify the Certificate and the Superior Court Stipulated Judgment will be placed on the Council meeting agenda scheduled for January 7, 2016.

Parties and intervenors are requested to submit comments or statements of position in writing to the Council with respect to whether the Request to Reopen and Modify the Certificate should be granted or denied and **whether a public hearing should be held on this request** by the close of business on or before January 4, 2016.
