On March 16, 2010, in Docket 370, the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") granted a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for The Connecticut Light and Power Company's ("CL&P's") Greater Springfield Reliability Project ("GSRP"). Condition #9 of the Council's Decision & Order directed that CL&P "provide the Council an operating report within three months after the conclusion of the first year of operation of all facilities herein, and annually thereafter for a period of three years, with information relevant to the condition, safety, reliability and operation of the transmission systems."
