
On March 16, 2010, in Docket 370, the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) granted a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for The Connecticut Light and Power Company’s doing business as Eversource Energy (Eversource) Manchester to Meekville Project (“MMP”). Condition #8 of the Council’s Decision & Order directed that Eversource “provide the Council an operating report within three months after the conclusion of the first year of operation of all facilities herein, and annually thereafter for a period of three years, with information relative to the condition, safety, reliability and operation of the transmission systems.”

Eversource submits the following information to the Council in compliance with Condition #8.

The MMP 345-kV line (circuit #3557) entered service on September 28, 2012. The overall condition and safety of the 345-kV line and associated facilities between Manchester Substation and Meekville Junction, both located in Manchester, Connecticut, has been excellent. There were no forced outages in 2017.
