Pursuant to provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50m and Section 16-50j-21 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, notice is hereby given that the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) will conduct a public hearing on June 29, 2010, beginning at 1:00 p.m. at the Connecticut Siting Council, 10 Franklin Square, Hearing Room 1, New Britain, Connecticut, and thereafter as necessary. This hearing will be on a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need, held by New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC, for the construction, maintenance and operation of a wireless telecommunications facility at the St. Matthew Lutheran Church, 224 Lovely Street, Ayon, Connecticut.
