Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless ("Cellco") hereby objects to Susan Edelson's June 15, 2009 request to submit two photographs into the record in the above-referenced proceeding.

Ms. Edelson attended the prehearing conference held by the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on April 30, 2009. At that conference, all parties and intervenors were notified that all testimony and exhibits should be prefiled by May 7, 2009. In response to this requirement, Ms. Edelson submitted prefiled testimony and exhibits. Ms. Edelson's prefiled testimony and exhibits were admitted into record at the evidentiary hearing in this matter held on May 14, 2009.

Since the photographs that Ms. Edelson now seeks to enter into the record were taken during "the winter months of 2008-2009," Ms. Edelson had these photographs available to submit as prefiled exhibits prior to the hearing or even on the day of the hearing.
