SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE OF CELLCO PARTNERSHIP D/B/A VERIZON WIRELESS  
TO CONNECTICUT SITING COUNCIL PRE-HEARING INTERROGATORIES NO. 7

On April 13, 2009, the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") issued Pre-Hearing Interrogatories to the Intervenor, Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless ("Cellco"), relating to the above-captioned docket. Cellco's responses were filed with the Council on April 29, 2009. Below is Cellco's supplemental response to Council Interrogatory No. 7.

Question No. 7

Did Cellco have a search ring in this area prior to the filing of this application? If so, provide a map depicting the search ring and describe the properties and/or structures identified for possible use prior to selecting the proposed site.

Response

Yes. Cellco established the search ring for its so called "Washington NE" cell site in June of 2004. This search area was discussed with the Council in the context of Cellco's Washington North application (Docket No. 332) and at the Council's Docket No. 332 hearing on June 21, 2007 and July 10, 2007. In Docket No. 332, Cellco RF Engineers described the future

need for an additional cell site to the east of its 6 Mountain Road (Washington North) tower site to provide continuous coverage along Route 202 between its then-proposed Washington North cell site and existing Litchfield SW cell site. Cellco was aware of Optasite's interest in the Tanner Farm property at that time and identified it as a location that could satisfy its Washington NE coverage objectives. A copy of Cellco's Search Ring Map for its Washington NE search area is included behind Attachment 3.

### **Supplemental Response**

**In addition to the Tanner Farm, Site A location presented in the SBA application, Cellco leased a portion of the property at 49 Couch Road on the Warren/Washington town line as another alternative that would satisfy its needs in the Washington NE search area. Attached is a Site Location Map showing the location of the 49 Couch Road site and its proximity to Site A and Site B on Tanner Farm. Also attached are copies of Cellco's lease exhibits showing the proposed cell site location at 49 Couch Road. Cellco's coverage objectives in the area could be satisfied at a height of 100 feet at this location (G.E. 1085' AMSL).**

**Cellco has not, to date, completed all of the necessary pre-application reviews, inspections and studies for a cell site at 49 Couch Road. These activities were put on hold because the SBA application was moving forward.**

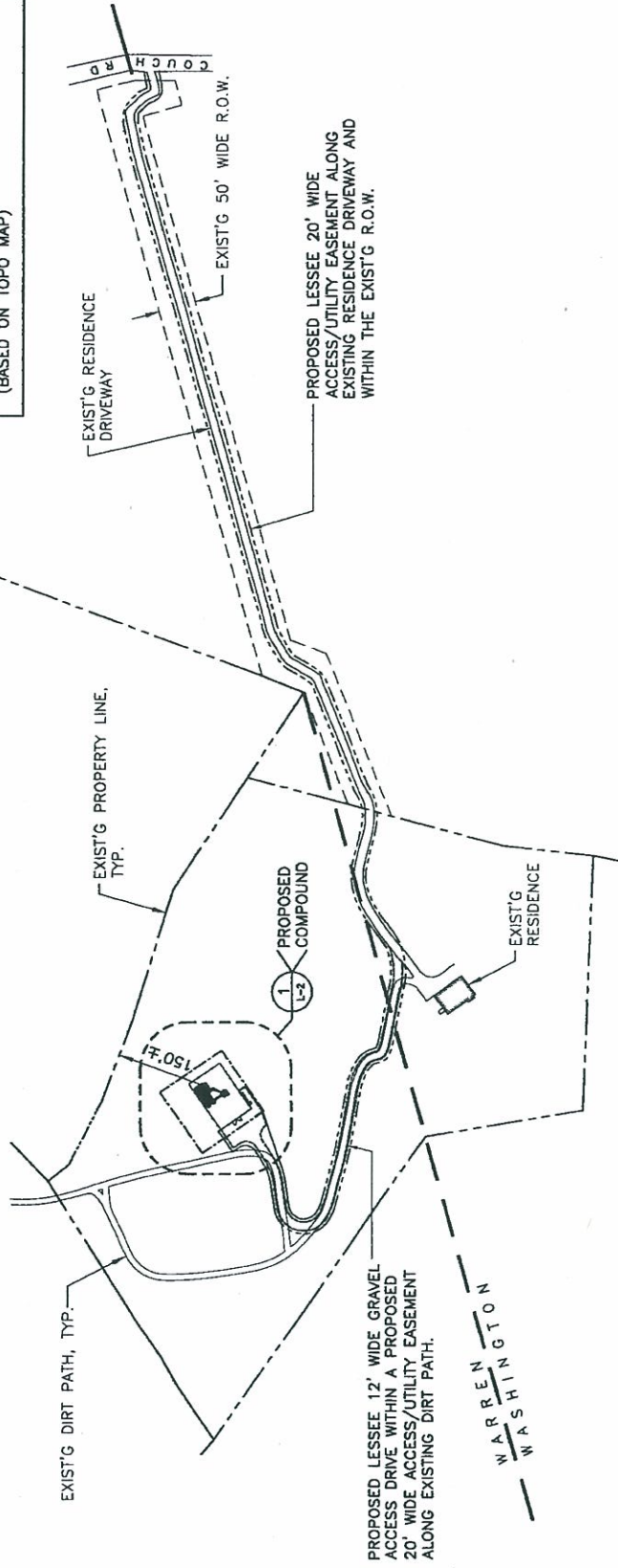

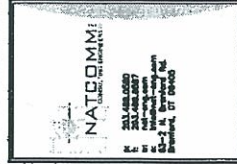

COMPOUND LOCATION PLAN

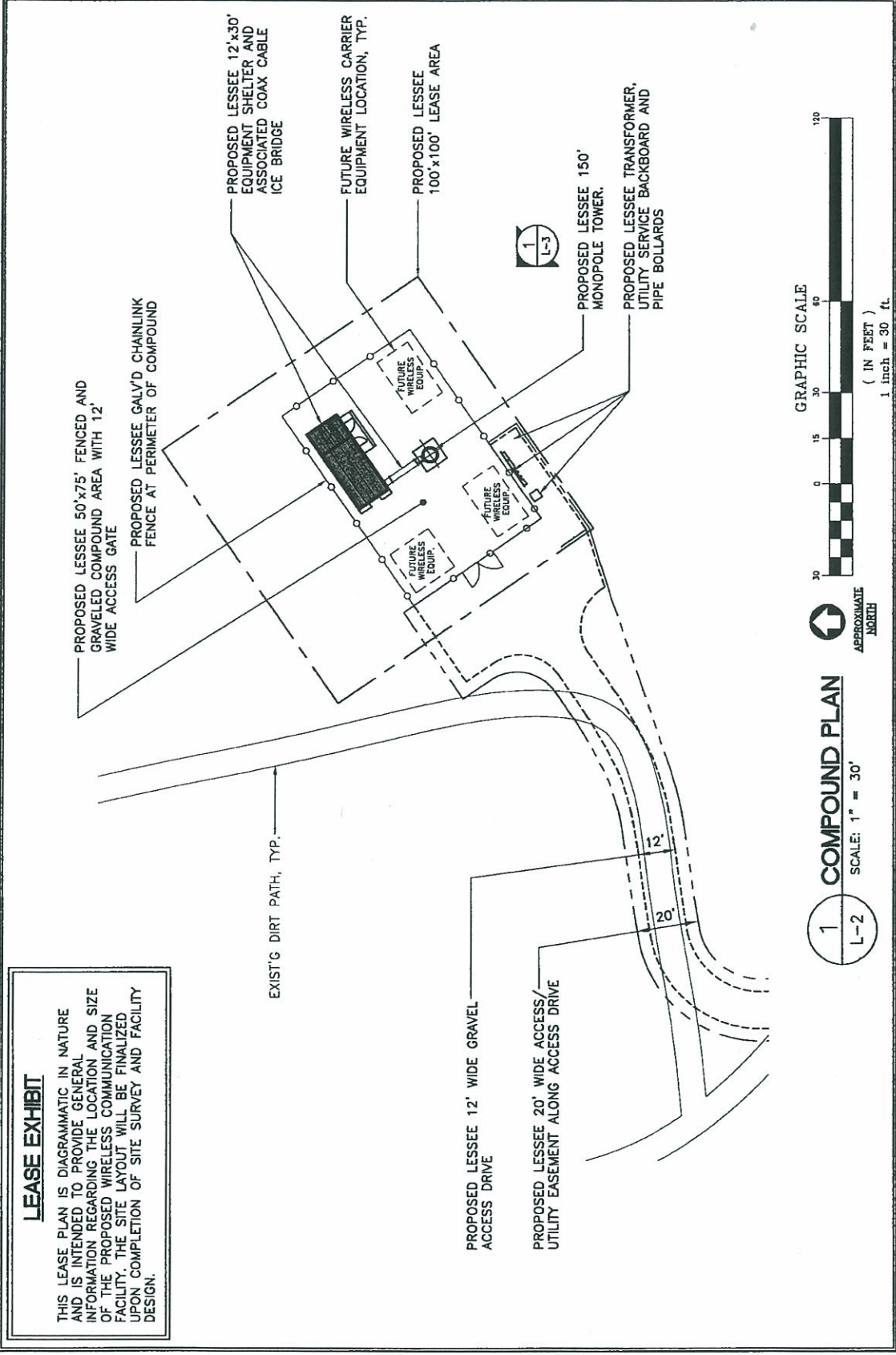

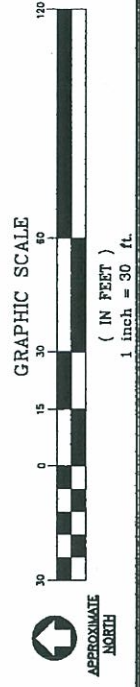

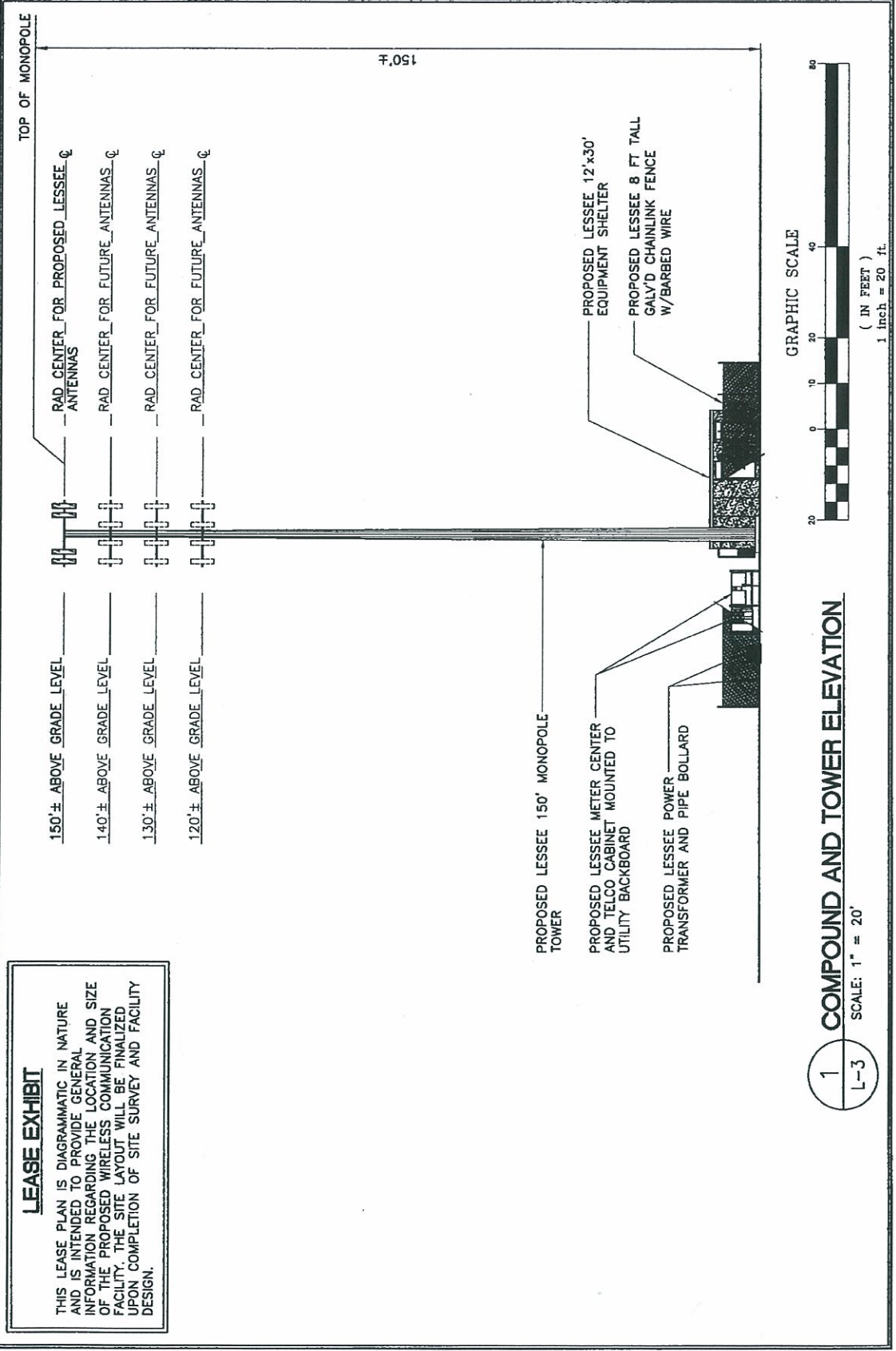
