**AFFIDAVIT REGARDING BALLOON FLOAT DURING FIELD REVIEW**


I, John S. Stevens, do hereby declare and state:

2. I am the founder, CEO and president of Infinigy Engineering & Surveying, PLLC, ("Infinigy").
3. I have personal knowledge of the above-captioned application for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need, filed with the Connecticut Siting Council ("Application") by Partnership, LLC ("Phoenix"), as well as the specific events attested to in this affidavit.
4. Phoenix retained Infinigy to provide engineering, surveying and environmental services, including a balloon float, for the proposed telecommunications facility to be located at 50 Devine Street, North Haven, Connecticut ("Facility").
3. On Tuesday, December 1, 2009, from 7:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m., I oversaw and/or supervised a balloon float at the site of the Facility, the purpose of which was to demonstrate the height of the tower proposed by Phoenix in the Application.
4. The balloon was flown at a height of 120 feet at the site of the proposed Facility.
