I, Michael Libertine, do hereby declare and state:


1. I am over the age of 18 years, and believe in the obligation of an oath.
2. I am the Director of Environmental Services for Vanasse Hangen Brustlin, Inc. ("VHB").
3. I have personal knowledge of the above-captioned application for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need, filed with the Connecticut Siting Council ("Application") by T-Mobile Northeast LLC ("T-Mobile"), as well as the specific events attested to in this affidavit.
4. T-Mobile retained VHB to provide a Visual Resource Evaluation Report , a wetlands compliance analysis and a coastal consistency analysis for the proposed telecommunications facility at 123 Pine Orchard Road, Branford, Connecticut (the "Facility").
5. On Tuesday, December 15, 2009, from 12:00 p.m. until 4:30 p.m., I oversaw and/or supervised a balloon float at the site of the Facility, the purpose of which was to demonstrate the height of the tower proposed by T-Mobile in the Application.

6. The balloon was flown at a height of 125 feet at the site of the proposed Facility.
