SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO COUNCIL CROSS-EXAMINATION

At the most recent hearing in the above referenced Docket, AT&T's radiofrequency engineering witness, Mr. Blevins, was asked whether AT&T had studied its network coverage along rail lines that traverse Old Lyme and include the Northeast Corridor Amtrak line from New York to Boston. Mr. Blevins testified yes, indicating that AT&T employees had ridden on the train to obtain information regarding coverage. He was then asked for follow up information regarding this process which is the purpose of this submission. AT&T tested its network coverage along the Northeast Corridor Amtrak line in early 2009 including through Connecticut. It was noted that coverage on Amtrak suffered from dropped calls and access failures in this part of the State in and near Old Lyme. That along with other data on the need for a site to provide reliable AT&T network coverage to residents, businesses and travelers in this shoreline area of the State, led AT&T to intervene in support of T-Mobile's proposed tower in Docket 391.
