Dear Attorneys Kohler and Langer:

The current deadline (with previous 120-day extension) for the above mentioned dockets is August 11, 2010. Given the complex nature of this combined proceeding and that the Connecticut Siting Council's (Council) earliest meeting in August is tentatively scheduled for August 12, 2010, additional time will be required to render a decision. Connecticut General Statute § 16-50p(a) provides, in part, that the Council render a decision "Not later than one hundred eighty days after the filing of an application for" a telecommunications tower "provided such time period may be extended by the Council by not more than one hundred eighty days with the consent of the applicant." The Council hereby requests such consent to extend for a final 60 days in Docket Nos. 391, 392 and 393 to October 10, 2010.
