RE: **DOCKET NO. 391** - T-Mobile Northeast, LLC application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility located 232 Shore Drive, Old Lyme, Connecticut.

DOCKET NO. 392 - T-Mobile Northeast, LLC application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility located 387 Shore Road, Old Lyme, Connecticut.

DOCKET NO. 393 - T-Mobile Northeast, LLC application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility located 61-1 Buttonball Road, Old Lyme, Connecticut.

As indicated in the hearing notice and field review notice, all three sites will be field reviewed on Thursday, February 4, 2010. However, given time constraints and the fact that we have additional intervenors (e.g. AT&T and Verizon Wireless) participating in Docket No. 391, the 3:00 p.m. evidentiary hearing on Thursday will involve only Docket No. 391 (232 Shore Road; the self-storage site). The cases involving the Docket No. 392 (387 Shore Road; the Laundromat site), and Docket No. 393 (61-1 Buttonball Road) applications will not be taken up. For the purposes of planning, Council Members may wish to bring only the application materials related to the D391 proceeding scheduled for February 4. (In order to dispense with one procedural item, however, a request for party status from Mary Staley, in conjunction with the D392 (Laundromat site) proceeding will be placed on the hearing program for Council action.)

In order to provide the public an opportunity to comment on three applications, the evening public comment session at 7:00 p.m. will be open for comments on all three sites. However, comments will be taken for one site at a time in order to keep the record organized and minimize confusion.

Also, for the purposes of planning, Council members are asked to observe that Tuesday, March 2, is currently held on the Council's schedule for the purpose of conducting a continuation of the above-referenced proceedings.

Finally, Council members are asked to observe the following three monikers when discussing these proceedings:

- Docket No. 391 (232 Shore Rd.) – The Self-Storage Site.
- Docket No. 392 (387 Shore Rd.) – The Laundromat Site.
- Docket No. 393 (61-1 Buttonball Rd.) – The Commercial Complex Site.
