SUPPLEMENTAL PRE-FILED TESTIMONY OF RAYMOND M. VERGATI

The following pre-filed testimony supplements my pre-filed testimony filed on January 28, 2010, in connection with the above-captioned matter.

Q12. Has T-Mobile offered the Town of Old Lyme the opportunity to co-locate its emergency services equipment on the Facility?

A12. Yes. T-Mobile has expressed to the Town of Old Lyme ("Town") its willingness to provide, free of charge, space on the proposed monopole for municipal public safety communications antennas. I spoke to David W. Roberge, the Town's Fire Marshal, via telephone and electronic mail. The Town had not expressed its intentions regarding co-location by the time of the hearing on February 4, 2010. Please see the email correspondence appended hereto as Attachment A.

Q13. Did you communicate with the Town regarding the opportunity to co-locate its emergency equipment on the Facility after the hearing on February 4, 2010?

A13. Yes. I communicated with David W. Roberge, the Town's Fire Marshal, via telephone and electronic mail. I asked the Town whether it had an interest in co-locating its emergency service antennae on the Facility. I also inquired whether co-locating on the facility proposed at the "Self-Storage" site, located at 232 Shore Road,

would obviate the Town's need for co-locating on the Facility. The Town has not provided a definitive response as of yet. Please see the email correspondence appended hereto as Attachment B.
