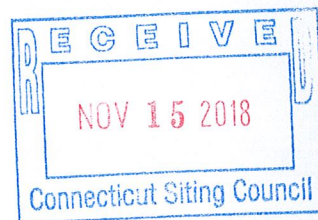

This letter serves to inform the Connecticut Siting Council (the “Council”) of a change in corporate ownership of the owner of the above referenced tower facility (the “Facility”), for which the Council issued a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need in Docket No. 399 (the “Certificate”).

On September 20, 2018, American Towers LLC (“American Tower”) acquired Municipal Bay, LLC, the owner of the Facility. As American Tower, via its wholly owned subsidiary Municipal Bay, LLC, now controls and operates the Facility, this letter serves as American Tower’s confirmation that the Facility remains in compliance with all of the terms and conditions contained in the Certificate pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §16-50k(b).
