Dear Chairman Stein:

The United Illuminating Company (“UI”) hereby notifies the Connecticut Siting Council (the “Council”) that construction of the telecommunications facility located at 100 Marsh Hill Road in Orange, Connecticut is complete and operational.

Further, in accordance with the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (“RCSA”) Sections 16-50j-77(c) and 16-50j-77(d), and the Council’s approval of the Development and Management Plan (“D&M Plan”) approved on March 17, 2011, UI is providing this Final Report for the telecommunications facility in Orange (the “Project”) to the Council.

Pursuant to RCSA Sections 16-50j-77(c) and 16-50j-77(d), the Final Report shall identify:

1. all agreements with abutters or other property owners regarding special maintenance precautions;
2. significant modifications to the D&M Plan that were required because of the property rights of underlying and adjoining owners or for other reasons;
3. the location of construction materials which have been left in place in the form of culverts, erosion control structures along watercourses and steep slopes, and corduroy roads in regulated wetlands;

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4. the locations of areas where special planting and reseeding have been done;
 5. agreements between the certificate holder and public agencies authorizing public recreational use of the site to the extent of the certificate holder's property rights thereto;
 6. the actual construction cost of the tower and associated equipment, including but not limited to the following costs:
 - a. construction of the tower and associated equipment;
 - b. rehabilitation; and
 - c. property acquisition for the site or access to the site.


