**Re: Proposed Telecommunications Facility
(Pleasant Point Road)**

To Whom It May Concern:

T-Mobile Northeast LLC ("T-Mobile") has filed an Application for a Certificate for Environmental Compatibility and Public Need ("Application") with the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") regarding certain real property commonly known as Pleasant Point Road, Branford and as Map H08, Block 2, Lot 1 on the Branford Assessor's Map ("Property"). T-Mobile seeks to construct, maintain and operate a telecommunications facility on the Property.

As required by General Statutes § 16-50f, T-Mobile provided all owners of land abutting the Property with notice of the Application. T-Mobile also published notice of the Application in the New Haven Register on September 18, 2010 and September 20, 2010.

This letter serves as an amended notice to address a scrivener's error in the previous notices and publications. The initial notice referenced 77-145 Pleasant Point Road, a parcel adjacent to the Property. The proposed access for the Facility would traverse 77-145 Pleasant Point Road. The Property does not have a street address.


T-Mobile submitted its Application the Council on or about October 1, 2010. The Application contained plans, satellite images, photo-simulations and environmental analyses of the Property. The Council has scheduled a hearing on the Application for January 25, 2011, at the Black Stone Library, 758 Main Street, Branford, Connecticut.

PUBLIC NOTICE

T-Mobile Northeast LLC ("T-Mobile") has filed an Application for a Certificate for Environmental Compatibility and Public Need ("Application") with the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") regarding certain real property commonly known as Pleasant Point Road, Branford, Connecticut, and as Map H08, Block 2, Lot 1 on the Branford Assessor's Map ("Property"). T-Mobile seeks to construct, maintain and operate a telecommunications facility ("Facility") on the Property.

T-Mobile's prior public notice, published in the New Haven Register on September 18 and 20, 2010, referenced the location of the proposed Facility as 77-145 Pleasant Point Road, which is a parcel adjacent to the Property. The proposed access for the Facility would traverse 77-145 Pleasant Point Road. The Property does not have a street address. The Application materials relate to the Property.

The proposed telecommunications facility would consist of a new 160 foot monopole structure with antennas mounted thereon, associated equipment and other site improvements necessary for the proposed facility ("Facility"). The location, height and other features of the Facility are subject to review and change by the Council pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50g *et seq.*

The Facility would provide wireless service in the Town of Branford, particularly to Route 146, Leetes Island Road and Pleasant Point Road, south of Interstate 95, as well as the surrounding area and the Amtrak rail line that passes through the area. The Application sets forth the need, purpose and benefits of the Facility and describes the environmental impact, if any, of the Facility.

T-Mobile will conduct a balloon float at the proposed height of the Facility on the day of the public hearing on the Application scheduled for January 25, 2011, or as otherwise scheduled by the Council. The Council will provide notice of the public hearing date. The Council will conduct that public hearing in Branford. The balloon float will take place between 12:00p.m. to 6:00p.m. or as set by the Council.
