I write on behalf of the applicant, T-Mobile Northeast LLC ("T-Mobile"), regarding the above-captioned proposed telecommunications facility ("Facility"). T-Mobile contacted Attorney Ainsworth, counsel for the Town of Branford ("Town"), to schedule a meeting regarding the Town's concerns about the Facility. T-Mobile and Town representatives met yesterday morning.


At this meeting, Town representatives asked T-Mobile to consider a two facility solution, with smaller facilities, in lieu of the Facility proposed at Pleasant Point Road. The first alternative location is a ball field in the Stony Creek neighborhood of the Town – an area the Town had previously requested that T-Mobile avoid because of resident opposition. The second location is on or near the existing Crown facility on Acorn Road.

Town representatives have assured T-Mobile that (1) the ball field in Stony Creek is a viable location; (2) the Town vetted the proposal with Stony Creek neighborhood representatives; and (3) the Town will support T-Mobile if it locates at that site instead of the proposed site at Pleasant Point Road.

T-Mobile would be remiss if it did not consider the Town's proposal and, therefore, concurs with the Town's request for a 90 day extension of time regarding the hearing currently scheduled for August 16, 2011.
