

We are in receipt of Siting Council interrogatories issued to New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC ("AT&T") in Docket 409A. As a courtesy to parties and intervenors and the Siting Council, we are writing to advise that AT&T's consultants will, depending on the weather, be in the field tomorrow, March 29, 2013. As part of the field work tomorrow, we anticipate that a balloon will be floated at the location of the proposed modified facility by AT&T's consultants and used to collect data and prepare the visibility analysis requested in interrogatory #4. There is no legal requirement to provide the Siting Council prior notice of a private balloon float by an applicant's consultants, yet we are doing so as a courtesy given the interest in this Docket expressed by two of the Town of Canaan's local agencies.
