Pre-Hearing Questions
Set Two

1. Provide the status of the Second Hill Road, Bridgewater tower proposal. Does New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (AT&T) plan to submit an application for that tower to the Connecticut Siting Council in the future? Approximately when would that be filed? If this application will not go forward, is AT&T considering other means to cover northern Bridgewater? Explain.
2. Provide existing and proposed coverage maps (neglecting the Second Hill Road site) for the tower at Wewaka Brook Road based on the proposed height, and 10 feet shorter, and 20 feet shorter. These should be a "zoomed in" version of what was already submitted, i.e. the maps should only cover areas in the vicinity of the Wewaka Brook Road site.
3. Comment on the differences in coverage between the proposed height, ten feet shorter, and 20 feet shorter. Explain the tradeoffs, if any, with the lower heights.
4. Could the 24 Dinglebrook Lane site provide adequate coverage to the target area at Wewaka Brook Road? At what height would AT&T antennas have to be located at the 24 Dinglebrook Lane site to provide adequate coverage to the service area? Explain.
