CONNECTICUT SITING COUNCIL DOCKET NO. 414


I, Michael Libertine, being duly sworn, deposes and states that:

1. I am over eighteen years of age and I understand the obligations of a statement under oath.
2. I am the Director of Environmental Services for Vanasse Hangen Brustlin, Inc. (“VHB”).
3. VHB has been working closely with the Docket No. 414 applicant, Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless in its application to construct a telecommunications facility at 36 Ritch Avenue, Greenwich, Connecticut.
4. Under my direction and supervision, VHB was responsible for the posting of the “Public Notice Sign” at the subject property. In accordance with Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) guidelines, the sign was posted on March 11, 2011, at least ten (10) business days prior to the scheduled public hearing on March 29, 2011.
5. The public notice sign posted at the property measures four (4) feet by six (6) feet and was posted along the site access driveway near the Ritch Avenue travel way. The text of the posted notice is as set forth in the Council’s Telecommunications Facility Application Guide. Photographs of the sign posted at the project site are attached to this affidavit.
