AMERICAN TOWER CORPORATION PRE-HEARING INTERROGATORIES

- 1. Did Cellco previously indicate interest in locating at American Tower's proposed redeveloped facility? If so, at what height? How was this height determined?
- 2. Why did American Tower decide not to proceed with replacement of the existing tower?
- 3. Please submit a visibility analysis of the proposed 140-foot redeveloped tower using a one-mile radius. Include a map that depicts projected visibility and photo-simulations of the tower. (Please refer to Cellco's application, Tab 6 for information regarding the form of a visibility analysis). Include an assessment from the abutting properties at 68, 80, and 99 West Quasset Road and from the Lake Wappaquasset area.
- 4. Is the location of the existing American Tower facility as shown in Cellco's Application Tab 1, accurate?
- 5. What is the ground elevation of the proposed redeveloped tower?
- 6. How many residences are within 1,000 feet of the existing American Tower facility? What is the distance and address of the nearest residence?
