**DOCKET NO. 419** - Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility located at 146 Old Colchester Road or 164 Old Colchester Road, Waterford,

Connecticut.

This completeness review is submitted in compliance with the Federal Communications Commission Declaratory Ruling that completeness of an application be determined within 30 days of receipt.

### I. Introduction

The application is from Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility and associated equipment in the Town of Waterford, Connecticut.

Cellco's facility would be located at one of two proposed sites: a 45.9-acre parcel at 146 Old Colchester Road or a 12.84-acre parcel at 164 Old Colchester Road. A facility at 146 Old Colchester Road would include a 130-foot monopole tower. A facility at 164 Old Colchester Road would include a 150-foot monopole tower.

# II. Technical

The application includes relevant maps, descriptions of the proposed prime and alternate site, costs, a description of the environmental effects of the proposed construction, and health and safety information. The application meets statutory technical requirements for processing the application. Council staff believes additional information can be obtained through prehearing interrogatories. This project would not require an outside consultant.

#### III. Administrative Review

The applicant has stated that all service and filing requirements pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50½ (b) have been fulfilled. The applicant stated that notice to the general public was published in the New London Day.

### IV. Procedural



The Council must schedule a hearing for the proceeding between 30 and 150 days after receipt of an application. The Council must also appoint a custodian of the docket and designate a place for the deposition of the transcript. Staff recommends designating Carriann Mulcahy as custodian of the docket, holding the public hearing in the Town of Waterford on August 9, 2011, and depositing the transcript in the Waterford Town Hall.V. <u>Proposed</u> Schedule
