RE: **DOCKET NO. 421** – T-Mobile Northeast LLC application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility located at 158 Edison Road, Trumbull, Connecticut.

During the meeting of the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) held on March 15, 2012, the Council denied T-Mobile's Objection to CATT's Written Cross Examination and voted to close the evidentiary record in this docket.

The Council announces that briefs and proposed findings of fact may be filed with the Council by any party or intervenor no later than April 16, 2012. The submission of briefs or proposed findings of fact are not required, rather the Council leaves it to the choice of the parties and intervenors.

Anyone who has not become a party or intervenor, but who desires to make his or her views known to the Council, may file written statements with the Council no later than April 16, 2012.

The Council also announces that state agencies desiring to submit additional comments on this application, pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50j, are to submit their comments to the Council no later than March 29, 2012.

The Council will issue draft findings of fact, and thereafter parties and intervenors may identify errors or inconsistencies between the Council's draft findings of fact and the record; however, no new information, no new evidence, no argument, -- and no reply briefs without permission -- will be considered by the Council.
