Dear Mr. Coppins:

At a public meeting of the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) held on May 29, 2014, the Council approved the transfer of the Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (Certificate) for the above referenced facility from T-Mobile Northeast LLC to Phoenix Partnership LLC. This approval of transfer is consistent with Connecticut General Statutes §16-50k(b) and conditioned on the consent of Phoenix Partnership LLC to comply with all the terms, limitations, and conditions contained in said Certificate issued on April 26, 2012, and on the timely payment of apportioned assessment charges for the facility under Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50v(b)(2).

During the public meeting held on May 29, 2014, the Council also considered your request for an extension of construction time in this docket, dated May 15, 2014, and granted a one-year extension of time until October 26, 2015, to complete construction of this project.

Pursuant to conditions 8 and 9 of the Certificate, any request for extension to fully construct this telecommunications facility with at least one fully operational wireless telecommunications carrier shall be filed with the Council not later than 60 days prior to the expiration of this Certificate and shall be served on all parties and intervenors, as listed on the current service list and the Town.

This extension is granted with the understanding that the Council will be notified should the certificate holder decide not to proceed with construction.
