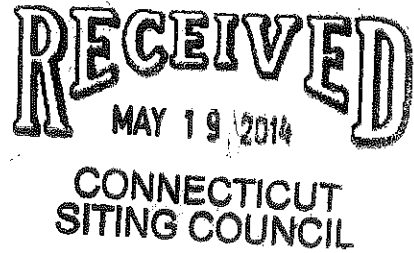

Transfer of Certificate and Extension of Time

Dear Attorney Bachman:

Phoenix Partnership, LLC (Phoenix") has recently acquired the wireless telecommunications facility that the Council approved in the above referenced Docket.

Phoenix requests that the Certificate granted by Decision and Order on April 26, 2012 in this Docket be transferred to Phoenix. Pursuant to the requirements of Connecticut General Statutes Section 16-50k(b), Phoenix agrees to comply with the terms and conditions contained in that Decision and Order. The transfer of this Certificate was not contemplated at any point during or prior to the Council's approval of the Docket No. 421 Certificate.

Further, Phoenix requests an extension of time to complete construction of this project. On May 1, 2013, the Council granted a one year extension of time to T-Mobile Northeast, LLC to complete construction by October 26, 2014. Phoenix requests that this completion date be extended for 1 year.

We would appreciate it if the Council would consider these matters at its next meeting.
