
Pursuant to RCSA Section 16-50j-62(b)(1) and (4), and as described in Volume 1, Section 7, of the *Development and Management (“D&M”) Plan for the Interstate Reliability Project (“Interstate”): Construction of New 345-kV Transmission Lines and Related Minor Modifications to Adjacent Lines*, The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy (Eversource) hereby provides to the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) this Notice of Completion for the Transmission Line portion of the Project.

After performing 10 months of environmental monitoring subsequent to the completion, in mid-October 2015, of Project right-of-way (ROW) restoration, Eversource determined, as of August 31, 2016, that the ROWs affected by Project transmission line construction are restored and rehabilitated. Accordingly, Project transmission line construction is complete.

The only remaining Project activities involve station work; specifically, the removal of special protection system (SPS) equipment at Lake Road Switching Station.
