LIST OF CORRECTIONS

- On sheet S-3A in Application Attachment 4(A), the call out as a swale is correct, but graphic depictions of contour lines are in the incorrect direction for a swale.
- On sheet S-8 in Application Attachment 4(A), barbed wire is shown. However, no barbed wire will be installed as discussed with the Town of Roxbury during the technical consultation.
- On sheet S-1 in the Application Attachment 4(A), Tax Map ID 34-028 is identified as belonging to North Atlantic Liquid Energy Corp. An updated owner of Michael & John A. Macura was obtained for the mailing of notice.
- In the Avian Resources Evaluation included as Attachment D to AT&T's Responses to Siting Council Interrogatories Set I, the Section regarding CTDEEP Natural Diversity Data Base (5th page of Attachment D) indicates that no known extant populations of state or Federal Endangered, Threatened or Special Concern Species are at or near Site A. In fact, although Candidate A does not fall within a shaded area on the CTDEEP NDDB Maps, correspondence dated January 26, 2011 from the CTDEEP Bureau of Natural Resources (included in Application Attachment 3(D) indicates that NDDB records (not mapping) reveal a State Special Concern Species, Eastern Box Turtle (*Terrapene carolina Carolina*) is in the vicinity of Candidate A and protective measures for the proposed Facility are outlined in Application Attachment 3(D). No rare avian species were identified.
