Dear Chairman Stein and Members of the Council:

On June 27, 2013, the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) approved an application by Celco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless (“Celco”) to construct a relocated wireless telecommunications facility on property owned by the American School for the Deaf at 139 North Main Street, West Hartford, Connecticut. The existing approval is due to expire on or about December 27, 2014.

Celco’s construction of the approved facility is progressing, but will not be completed before the December 27, 2014 deadline. Celco, therefore, respectfully requests that the Council grant a six (6) month extension to the Docket No. 434 approval giving Celco until June 27, 2015, to complete construction of this facility and activate the site.
