On behalf of Message Center Management, Inc. (“MCM”) and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (“AT&T”), please accept this letter regarding the captioned Facility for which the Siting Council issued a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need in Docket 439 (“Certificate”).

Condition 7 of the Decision and Order dated October 31, 2013 required the approved facility to be fully constructed and providing wireless services within eighteen months from the date of the mailing of the Council’s Findings of Fact, Opinion, and Decision and Order.

While the tower is constructed, AT&T continues at this time to make arrangements for communication data service to the tower site. In keeping with condition 6 of the Decision and Order we respectfully request an extension of the Certificate’s allowed completion time to December 31, 2015.
