The Department of Transportation has reviewed the above-mentioned docket and offers the following comments.

The proposed project has utility work within the State of Connecticut right of way on State Route 109 (Blackville Road) which would result in new curbing, paving, realignment, tree/brush cutting or removal. Therefore, AT&T must obtain a permit pursuant to the Highway Encroachment Permit Regulations in conjunction with the Connecticut General Statutes prior to performing any work within the state right of way.

The District 4 Permit Office will need four complete sets of construction plans which show all work within the state right of way, all site work, and any required easements and standard details for highway construction prior to issuing the encroachment permit.
