Dear Executive Director Bachman:

On behalf of our client, New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (“AT&T”), please accept this letter regarding the captioned Facility for which the Siting Council issued a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need in Docket 442 (“Certificate”).

Condition 6 of the Decision and Order dated May 29, 2014 required the approved facility to be fully constructed and providing wireless services within eighteen months from the date of the mailing of the Council’s Findings of Fact, Opinion, and Decision and Order.

AT&T is still in the process of coordinating final utility easement approval between the state and the utility companies. As such AT&T will require additional time to complete this process as well as finalize construction and building permitting information prior to commencing construction. Accordingly, we respectfully request an approximately one-year extension of the Certificate’s allowed completion time to December 31, 2016 to permit sufficient time for the completion of the approved Facility.
