We are writing to you on behalf of our client New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (“AT&T”) with respect to the above referenced matter and our client’s intent to file an application with the State of Connecticut Siting Council for approval a proposed wireless communications tower facility (the “Facility”) within the Town of Southbury.

State law requires that record owners of property abutting a parcel on which a facility is proposed be sent notice of an applicant’s intent to file an application with the Siting Council. The Facility candidate is located at 257 Perkins Road, and is identified as Map 5-85-B4 by the Town of Southbury Tax Assessor. NOTICE

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-50l(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Section 16-50l-1(e) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies of an Application to be filed with the Connecticut Siting Council (“Siting Council”) on or after October 15, 2013 by New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (“AT&T” or the “Applicant”) for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need for the construction and maintenance of a wireless telecommunications facility in Southbury, Connecticut.

The proposed facility is located at 257 Perkins Road which is identified as Map 5-85-B4 by the Southbury Tax Assessor. The proposed facility is located in the southern portion of a 3.038 parcel and is proposed as a 170’ AGL monopole with antennas at the top. The tower, antennas and ground equipment will be located within a 38’ x 60’ fenced equipment compound area. Vehicle access to the facility would be provided by an existing gravel drive in addition to a new gravel drive extension 12’ in width.

The location, height and other features of the proposed Facility are subject to review and potential change under provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes Sections 16-50g et. seq.

The Facility is being proposed to allow AT&T and other carriers to provide wireless services in this area of the State. The Application explains the need, purpose and benefits of the facility and also describes the environmental impacts of the proposed facility. The facility will be available for co-location by other wireless carriers.

A balloon, representative of the proposed height of the facility, will be flown at the proposed site on the first day of the Siting Council public hearing on the Application, which will take place in the Town of Southbury, or such other date specified by the Siting Council and a time to be determined by the Siting Council, but anticipated to be between the hours of 12pm and 5pm.


