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In reference to the above-mentioned application, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) wishes to take administrative notice of the following 3 items:

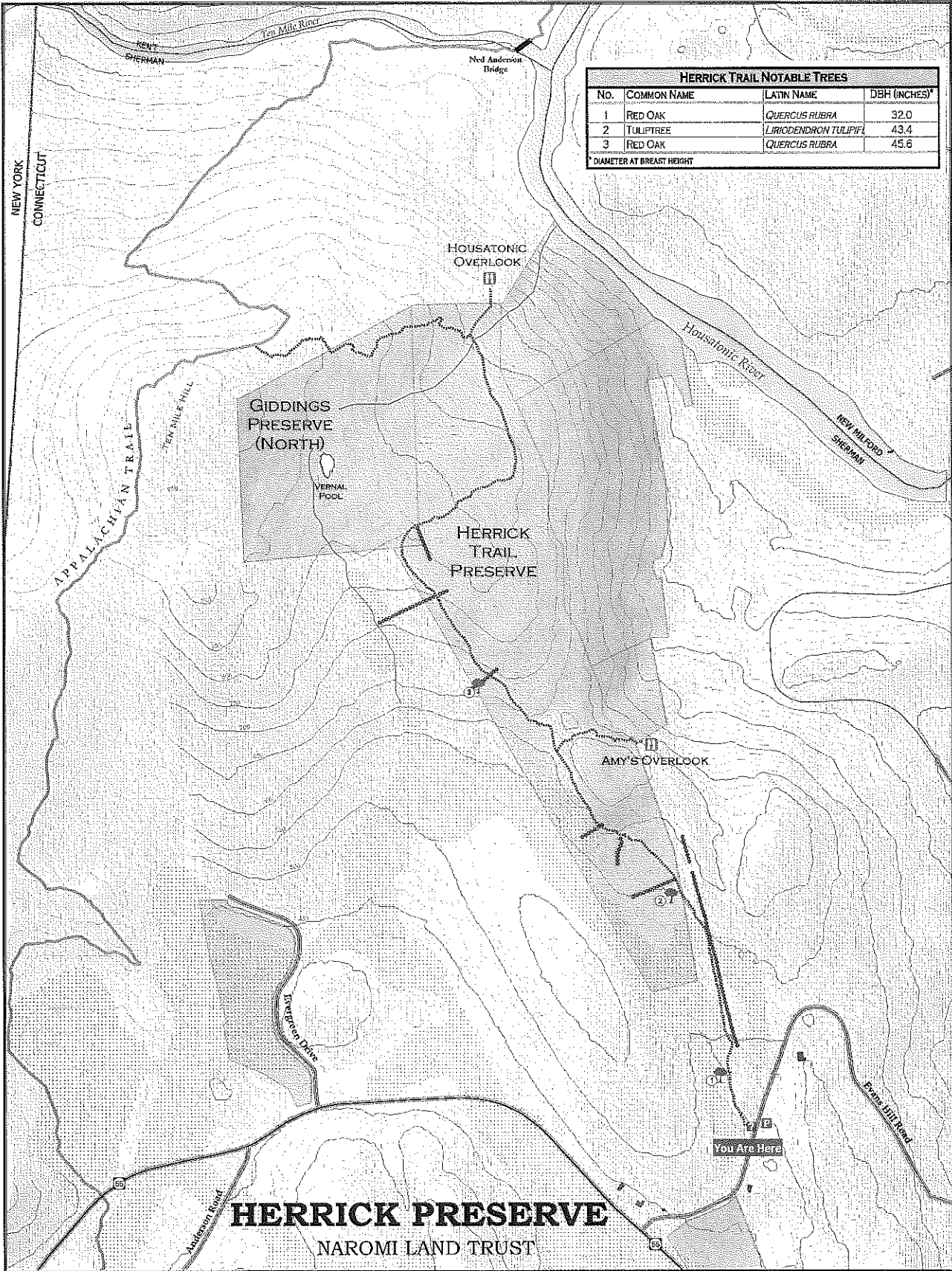
